Practise sounds and letters names from your red book.

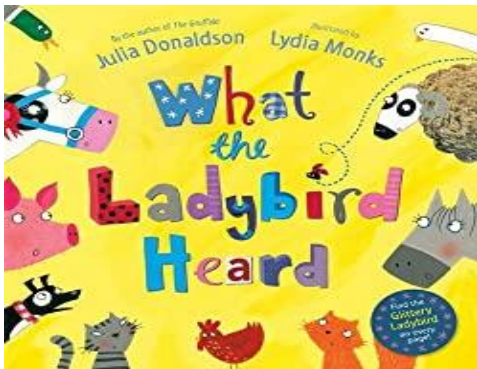
Practise reading and writing 5 tricky troll words: to, the, I, no, go

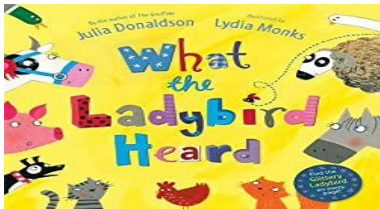
Activity 1 – Literacy
