Dear Parents/Carers,

During this period of self-isolation until returning to school on Wednesday 2nd December 2020, please find below details regarding your child's home learning and activities that will be set by their class teacher.

Your child's class teacher has prepared a weekly learning pack for your child in the form of a PowerPoint that can easily be accessed via our school website www.oasisbyron.org under the home learning tab or by collecting a hard copy from school by calling 0208 668 4877 or emailing at byron@oasisbyron.org. The PowerPoint will be uploaded on Sunday, ready for learning on Monday. Pupils will be expected to work through the lessons that are clearly labelled for each day.


Some of the tasks require the children to virtually 'hand in' a piece of learning. You may find it easier to email a photograph of the learning.

Should you have any questions about the learning for each day, please email your child's class teacher using the email below between the hours of 9am – 10am. They will endeavour to reply as quickly as possible with any responses related to any tasks set for that particular day.

Please feel free to email your child's class teacher with any other questions throughout the day but try and leave the early slot for questions specifically about the learning for that day. The teacher will do their best to get back to you as soon as possible but please do allow 24 hours' notice.

It would be very beneficial for your child to read each day or share story time with an adult. Encouraging your child to use their phonics learning to read will ensure consistency with usual school practice. When reading or after reading, asking your child different questions such as 'Why did...?' 'How might...?' and 'Why do you think...?' will support their understanding of what they have read.

PURPLE MASH

If your child  has access to online learning, we also have our own safe online learning platform called Purple Mash with many educational activities that your child may enjoy doing if they have any additional time. A separate letter with password details will be sent to the email address we hold for you.
