We are delighted to inform you that we have managed to secure a two-week block of swimming lessons for year 3 at Waddon Swimming pool, running from **Monday 11**th **July to Friday 22**nd **July.** The lessons are one hour long, and we are very fortunate to have three swimming instructors.

Swimming is a compulsory element of the National Curriculum, and all pupils are expected to attend every session. Your child should bring his/her swimming kit and towel into school **every day** for these two weeks. As the weather is so unpredictable at the moment, please ensure that your child has a waterproof coat or if the weather is hot, please provide a sun hat.

The children will be travelling by public transport to and from the swimming pool and we would be delighted if a couple of parents could volunteer each day to accompany the children. Please indicate on the form below if you can attend and the class teacher will let you know when help is required.

Each day, the lessons will start at 1pm, therefore, the children shall need a packed lunch daily, for these two weeks. Please let us know on the form below if your child is entitled to free school meals and the school kitchen will then provide them with a lunch. Year 3 class will aim to be back to school for 3:20pm but we shall keep you updated each day should there be any delay due to traffic.
