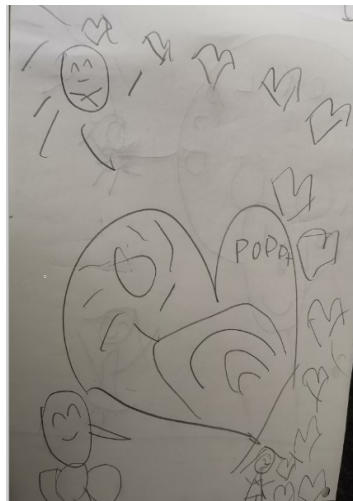
## What you are doing!
