



NEWS UPDATE

Another year starts and we are delighted to welcome our new families to our **Reception** class.

We are already fully back into the swing of another school year here at Oasis Academy Byron with lots of letters going out about upcoming outings, events and clubs so make sure you check with your child so that they don't miss out.

You may have noticed that we have installed an electronic logging system to the Office Reception area. This will further improve site security and emergency evacuation procedures.

Visitors and children who arrive late for school must be signed in and out (normally by the person bring or collecting them). Simply click on the 'Pupil' record on screen and enter your child's details. This system will also apply to children collected early or late.

The school day starts at 8.55 a.m. promptly, when all children should be in their classes and ready to start the learning day and finishes at 3.15 p.m. for infants and 3.20 p.m. for juniors.

AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS

This term's after-school activity clubs have now started and there are still some spaces left on Papercrafting for years 2 to 4 (see right!) and Yogatastic for years 4 to 6 .
