DON'T FORGET THAT SCHOOL IS CLOSED TOMORROW (FRIDAY) FOR AN INSET DAY!

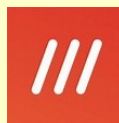
Year 3 trip to the National Gallery

SAFEGUARDING NEWS—what3words



This is a new phone app which simplifies your location.

In the app, each 3m square in the world has been given a unique 3 word address that will never change. It can be used to find tents at festivals, navigate to B&Bs and to direct emergency services to the right place. It is as precise as GPS coordinates, but more concise and easier for people to use.

For example, the school office's co-ordinates are '///swept.desire.hired' whilst the Children's Centre is '///roses.burns.plenty'

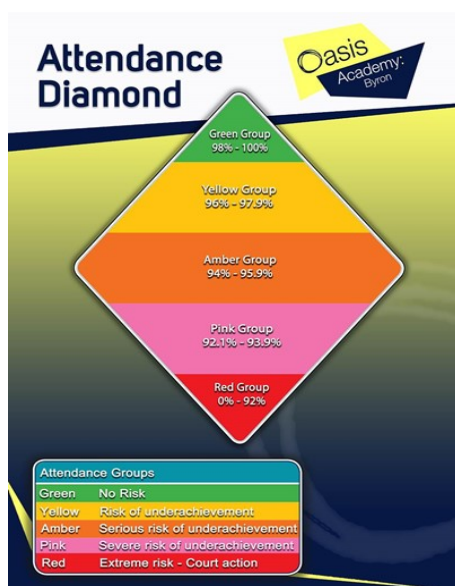
