Dear Parents/Carers,

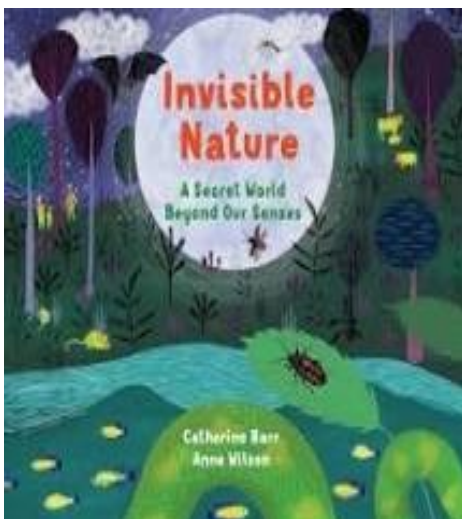
Congratulations to Avelyn in year 3 for achieving her Level 1 Award in Graded Examination in Dance: Grade 1 (Ballet).

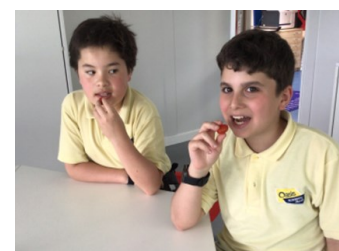

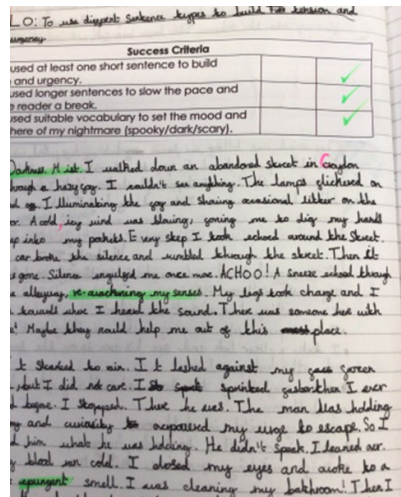
