Vouchers


If your child is entitled to free school meals, you will be sent a voucher via email from Friday 17th December 2021.

Spring Term Updates:

PE Days:

As we start back in the spring term, we would like all children to come into school on their PE days in their school PE Kit. Considering the weather, this should be blue/black plain jogging bottoms, school PE T shirt and school jumper, with trainers or plimsolls.

All PE kits will go home at the end of this term and should not be brought back in January. Class teachers will remind the children of their PE day in the first week back in January.

Above 97%: Less than 6 days absence a year

Excellent attendance! These young people will almost certainly get the best grades they can, leading to better prospects for the future. Pupils will also get into a habit of attending school which will help in the future.

95%: 10 days absence a year

These pupils are likely to achieve good grades and form a habit of attending school regularly. For instance, pupils who take a 2-week holiday every year can only achieve 95% attendance.

90%: 19 days absence a year

The Government classes young people in this group as "Persistent Absentees", and it will be almost impossible to keep up with work. Parents of young people in this group could also face the possibility of legal action being taken by the Local Authority.



Along with all schools, we run under strict financial controls and are not permitted to carry debts on Parentpay accounts. Please make sure that your child has a sufficient on-account balance to cover breakfast and/or lunch meals as needed.

With effect from 1st January 2021 Breakfast Club is £3.00 a

day for each child that attends and school lunches are currently £2.35 a day.


