COVID GUIDANCE UPDATE

The population now has a much stronger protection against COVID-19 than at any other point in the pandemic. This means we can begin to manage the virus like other respiratory infections. Adults with symptoms of a respiratory infection and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature.

We are still continuing to take measures to limit the spread of Covid within school as advised by Public Health.

My child has tested positive for COVID-19- how long to do they have to stay away from school for?

Children and young people aged 18 and under, who test positive and are unwell or have a high temperature are advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days. They can come back to school when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend. If your child is absent from school please email byron@oasisbyron.org before 9am on each morning of their absence. Please note that any Covid absences will now be recorded in registers as an illness like any other and will therefore affect your child's attendance.

Testing

Regular asymptomatic testing is no longer recommended in any education setting. Free testing for COVID-19 will end for most people . You may still be able to get free rapid lateral flow tests if you work for the NHS or in social care, are going into hospital, or you're at high risk of getting seriously ill from COVID-19.


Y3 and Y4 Science Club:
